### We support 17 local agencies and 36 programs focused on:

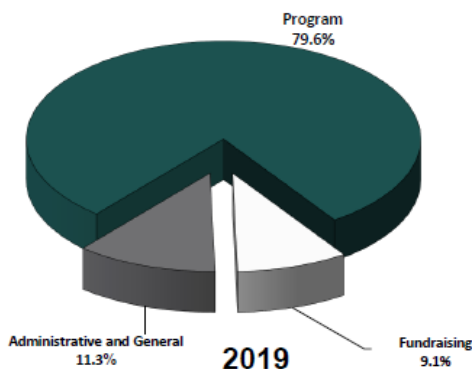

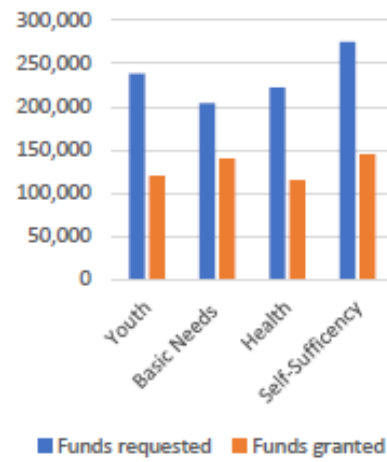
