As the school year is in swing, we want to extend our deepest gratitude to each one of you who contributed to making Stuff the Bus 2024 such a **tremendous success**. Thanks to the generosity of our community, we're thrilled to share the impact we made together for families and students in Washington County.

One of the challenges we often hear from parents is the financial strain of purchasing school supplies each year. At United Way, we recognize this need and are committed to easing that burden. When we provide essential supplies, we give students the confidence to start the school year ready to learn and succeed. It's a vital way we're working to build a stronger community, one backpack at a time.



Our goal this year was ambitious: to fill 600 backpacks with the supplies needed for students to begin the school year with heads held high—and we surpassed it, **filling 618 backpacks!** This was only possible because of the many generous donations, sponsorships, and all our incredible collection sites.
